# Virginia Green Travel Alliance Announces Winners of the **2025 Virginia Green Travel Star Awards**At the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Virginia Green Travel Conference on March 20<sup>th</sup>!

RICHMOND, VA. – The Virginia Green Travel Alliance is pleased to announce the winners of the 2024/25 Virginia Green Travel Star & Leader Awards. These awards are presented annually to Virginia's greenest tourism operators and partners for their outstanding commitments to sustainability and contributions to green tourism in Virginia. The awards are presented in conjunction with the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Virginia Green Travel Conference that was held March 20-21, 2025 at Busch Gardens in Williamsburg, Virginia.

This year, ten (10) Virginia tourism operators were chosen to receive the Virginia Green Travel program's highest award, the *Virginia Green Travel Star Award*. Seven (7) additional tourism businesses were recognized with the *Virginia Green Travel Leader Award* for their continued commitments to environmental stewardship, and six (6) individuals received the *Green Team All-Star Award* for their efforts to lead their organizations' green programs. Seven (7) organizations also received honorable mention recognition for their continued efforts as committed Virginia Green Travel Partners.

Finally, award winners competed in the 3rd annual Virginia Green Travel People's Choice Award, which is a social media contest to promote themselves and their awards. The four most popular winners are listed below.

All of the awards were presented on March 20th during a reception and awards celebration. Please see the list below of all the award winners.

"The Virginia Green Travel Certification program works to support and recognize tourism businesses and organizations that are committed to reducing the environmental impacts of their operations," says Tom Griffin, the Executive Director of the Virginia Green Travel Alliance. The Virginia Green Travel program is run through a partnership between the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, the Virginia Tourism Corporation, Virginia State Parks, the Virginia Restaurant, Lodging & Travel Association, and the Virginia Green Travel Alliance. The program encourages green practices in all sectors of Virginia's tourism industry. More than 1,200 businesses and partner organizations have voluntarily certified

their green commitments through the Virginia Green Travel program.
